- 1. Applicable Education (lessons, workshops, hands on activities, etc.)
- 2. Local garden, farm, greenhouse or food growing projects (e.g. after-school programs, culinary classes utilizing local foods, teaching)

Guidelines for Submitting a Proposal:

Proposals may not exceed two pages in length and must include organization basics (type of organization and general contact information), project description, proposal, timeline, and project budget. Proposals that are longer than two pages will not be considered. Grant Reports are due 30 days after project completion.
